

WORKSHOP FITTER/STOREMAN

Reporting to the Engineering Manager your responsibilities will include:

- Inspection, repair, and service of centrifugal pumps, gear pumps, and diaphragm pumps.
- Day to day running of the warehouse, spare parts, and fabrication workshop
- The assembly and fabrication of pump, motor bases.
- Installing and aligning couplings, v-belts, and pulleys on pumps and motors.
- Ensuring the end products meet the Hydro Innovations Quality Standards
- Effectively handle multiple priorities, organise workload, and meet project deadlines
- Pick and package pumps and spare parts for delivery
- Unload shipping containers and place items into stock
- Maintain organisation and cleanliness of warehouse, spare parts room, and workshop

To be considered for this role you should:

- Have a broad knowledge of pumps and parts
- Have some experience working with pump assemblies, i.e., seals, bearings, impellers, shafts, and rotating assemblies.
- Be experienced reading, interpreting and working to drawings and diagrams
- Have experience working with and servicing diesel engines.
- Be an experienced welder in TIG, MIG, welding mild steel, stainless steel, and sheet metal.
- Operate a variety of hand, power, and shop tools
- Practice and perform to OH&S standards
- Self-motivated and organised
